SYNOPSIS

Two grown sisters get together in an emergency meeting to decide what to do about "Mama Angel." Lily has taken care of her for years but is now beside herself. A care facility is out of the question, because the sisters have a well-guarded and tainted past, and Angel *TALKS!* She needs her medication or she'll die, and the more medication she takes the louder and less inhibited she gets.
